


Total Depletions Above Elm Creek

II. IDENTIFICATION OF SECOND INCREMENT INTENT

2nd Increment Target Goals

- Post-1997 use depletions (33,800 AF at end of second increment) Statutory Requirement
- Maintain first increment mitigation efforts (estimated depletion offset of 43,600 126,200AF)
 - Offset 2nd Increment growth in depletions from post-1997 uses (3,500 AF)
 - Offset 2nd Increment growth in depletions from pre-1997 uses (41,000 AF)
 - Offset growth in depletions since 1997 of all uses (105,200 AF within higher end of offset estimate)
